- Create own maps and keys

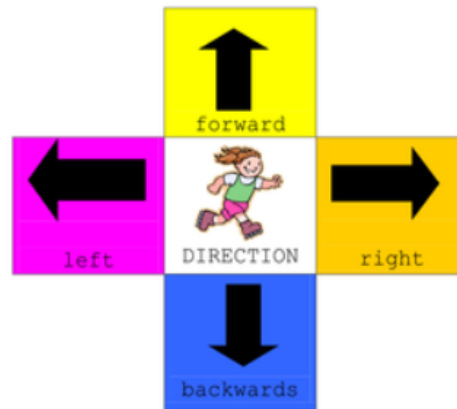
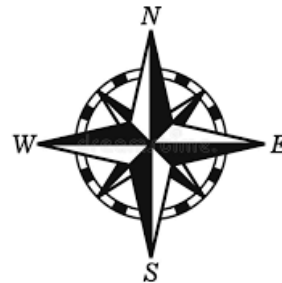
Directions

Word	Picture	Definition
capital city		A big city in a country where the government is. The capital city of the United Kingdom is London.
map		A drawing of the earth's surface. It shows the features of a place and how to go from one place to another.
symbols		A symbol on a map shows what and where something is. For example, a church, a car park or a shop.
key		A list of symbols that can be seen on a map and what they mean.
directions		Directions help people get from one place to another.
