

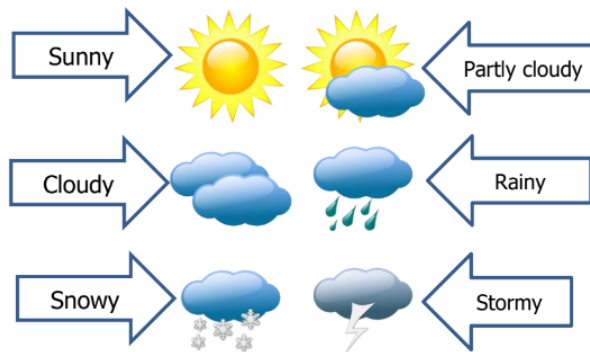

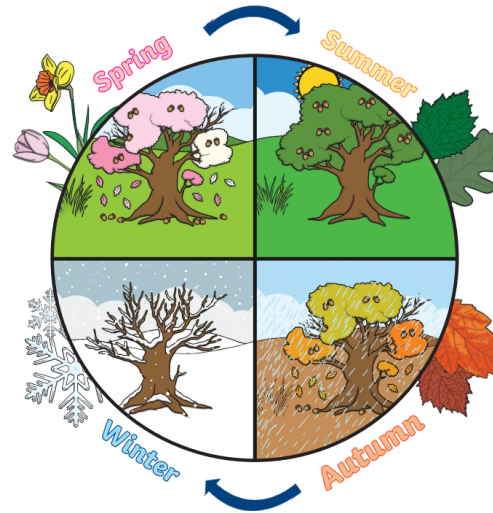

#### Seasons

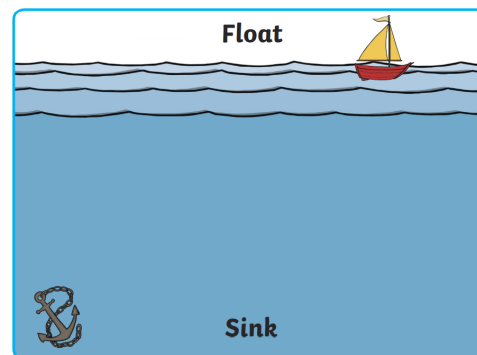
There are four seasons each year.



#### Floating and Sinking

Float- when an object rests on the surface of the water.

Sink-when an object falls to the bottom of the water.



### Key Vocabulary

Word	Picture	Definition
Spring		The weather starts to get warmer. Plants begin to grow and you may see baby animals like lambs around.
Summer		The weather gets hotter. The daytime is long and the nights are short.
Autumn		The weather begins to get colder. Leaves start to fall from the trees. Daylight becomes less.
Winter		The weather is much colder. It sometimes snows. The daytimes are the shortest in the year and the night times are the longest.
Humidity		Humidity is a measure of how much water there is in the air. Not liquid water like rain, invisible water in the form of a gas called water vapour.
