



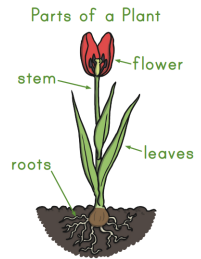

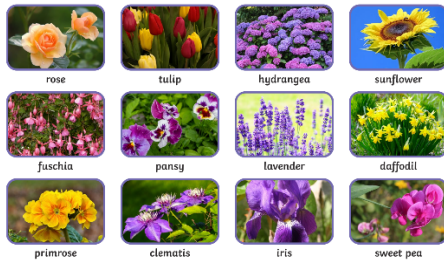

Wild Plants

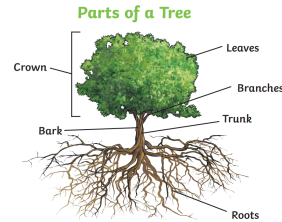
A wild plant will grow by itself and does not need to be cared for



Skills

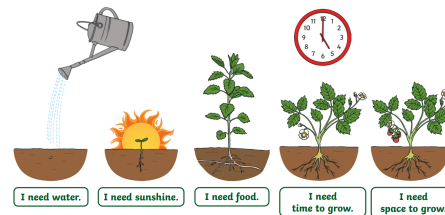

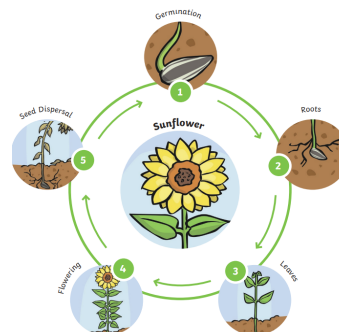
