




Key Knowledge and Skills

Key Vocabulary	
Word	Definition
User	Someone who uses a particular thing.
Purpose	The reason for which something is done or created.
Design	A plan or drawing produced to show the look.
Functional	To have a special purpose,
Aesthetics	An appreciation of beauty or nice to look at.
Fabric	Cloth or other material produced by weaving or knitting fibres.
Stitch	A loop of thread or yarn resulting from a single pass or movement of the needle in sewing.
Seam	A line where two pieces of fabric are sewn together.
Pattern	A repeated decorative design.
Template	A shaped piece of rigid material used as a pattern for processes such as cutting out, shaping, or drilling.
Finishing	To neaten the raw edges of a plain seam to prevent ravelling.
Evaluate	To form an idea about something you have done or check how well it has worked.
Technique	A way of carrying out a particular task, especially the completion or performance of an artistic work.
Marking	A popular or the latest style of clothing, hair, decoration, or behaviour.
