Who were the Maya Civilisation?

The Maya civilisation began long ago in a place called Mesoamerica. This huge area is made up of Mexico and part of Central America. The Maya first developed their civilisation in around 2000 BC (the Pre-classic period).



What did Maya society look like?

Maya society was very complex with hundreds of cities, commoners, a middle class, nobles and the king and his royal court. The Maya built amazing cities like Tikal (which they called Yax Mutal) and Palengue. Even though they lived in different cities, ruled by different kings and queens, the Maya shared a lot of common beliefs and traditions.



Maya Beliefs and **Traditions**

The Maya believed that their rulers could communicate with the gods and their dead ancestors through the ritual of bloodletting. It was a common practice for the Maya to pierce their tongue, or cut themselves with an obsidian (stone) knife. Mayan kings were the most important priests. They were seen as the link between humans and gods. When the kinds died themselves. they became gods.

Maya Gods

The Maya worshipped many Gods. Mayan gods could changed themselves into human and animal form. Priests performed ceremonies to keep the gods happy.
