	Word	Definition
	Collage	a piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing
	watercolour	artists' paint made with a water-soluble binder such as gum arabic, and thinned with water rather than oil, giving a transparent colour
	botanical	relating to plants
	impressionist	The artists representation of the object rather than a photo like representation
	conservationist	A person who advocates or acts for the protection and preservation of the environment and wildlife.
	3D	the quality of being three-dimensional.
	mood	inducing or suggestive of a particular feeling or state of mind
	perspective	the art of drawing solid objects on a two-dimensional surface so as to give the right impression of their height, width, depth, and position in relation to each other when viewed from a particular point.
	inspiration	the process of being mentally stimulated to do or feel something, especially to do something creative
	foreground	the part of a view that is nearest to the observer, especially in a picture or photograph
