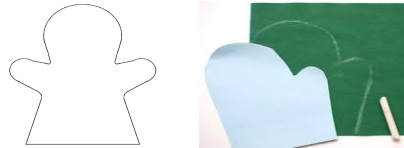
Explore and Evaluate

glove puppet



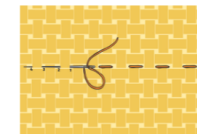
A puppet that fits over the hand, and the fingers move the head and arms.
