<p><u>Heroes and heroines of the Past</u></p> <p><u>Florence Nightingale (1820 - 1910)</u></p>  <p>- A nurse who went to help soldiers in the Crimean War. - 'The Lady with the Lamp'.</p> <p><u>Mary Seacole (1805 - 1881)</u></p>  <p>- A nurse in the Crimean War but was refused because of the colour of her skin.</p> <p><u>Changes to hospitals and nursing</u></p> <p><u>THEN</u></p>  <p><u>NOW</u></p> 	<p><u>Nelson Mandela (1918 - 2013)</u></p>  <p>- Went to prison for 27 years for standing up for the unfair treatment of black people. - The first black president of South Africa.</p> <p><u>Jesse Owens (1913 - 1980)</u></p>  <p>- Athlete who won 4 gold medals in the Berlin Olympic Games in 1936.</p> <p><u>The First Olympic Games</u></p> <p>- Started over 2,700 years ago in Greece. - Only men and boys could take part. - A few sports</p> <p><u>The Modern Olympic Games</u></p> <p>- Started up in 1896 for athletes from all around the world. - Takes place in a different city every 4 years. - 40 sports</p>  	Word	Picture	Definition
