As part of our Science work in our Disney topic this term, we have arranged for Classes 4, 5 and 6 to visit Yorkshire Wildlife Park on Monday 6th November 2023.

Children will need to arrive at the academy at the normal time of 8.40am and we will aim to be back in time for home time as normal at 3.05pm

The children will need a packed lunch and a drink (no fizzy drinks). They will also be required to wear school uniform to make it easier to identify the children whilst we are at Yorkshire Wildlife Park. Please send your child with a warm waterproof jacket and sensible shoes.

Please complete your consent and make payment on your ParentPay account by Monday 6th November. If your child is eligible to receive a free school meal and would normally have a school dinner in school, please also select on ParentPay if you would like school to provide your child with a packed lunch for the trip.

We would be grateful for a contribution of £19.00 towards the cost of the trip. A pupil will not be excluded from the activity because his or her parents/carers have not contributed. However, if there are insufficient contributions overall, the activity will not be able to go ahead. We ask that you make payment via ParentPay. To do this please log in to your ParentPay account and select the Trip to give your consent and complete your contribution.

During this trip, we will be taking part in a workshop called 'Furs, Feathers and Scales'.

"Students will identify and name a range of animals from different animal groups. Animal bio-facts will be used to group animals in various ways and there will be a chance to handle live animals."
