Dear Parents / Carers,

I am pleased to be able to share with you the confirmed statutory assessment data for our academy for the 2022-2023 academic year. These results are presented in tables on the next few pages, and compare the performance of our academy against local authority and national data. The data can also be seen on the 'Attainment Information' tab of our website.

The delay in presenting this data is due to the fact that all schools must await the conclusion of the national appeals processes relating to the marking of tests before data can be published.

It is widely acknowledged that the pandemic has had a significant impact on children's learning; as such, this data set represents the first academic data that schools have been required to publish since the end of the pandemic, and I am sure that parents will be pleased to see that the academy has performed well across all age phases – Early Years, Key Stage 1, and Key Stage 2.

A gap of 5% above the national average is classed as statistically significant. The *Reading*, *Writing*, *and Mathematics Combined* results *at the Expected Standard* are particularly important measures, and it is pleasing therefore that at the end of **Key Stage 1** the academy achieved results **8% above** the national average, whilst performance at the end of **Key Stage 2**, by the time the pupils leave the academy, climbed to **19% above** the national average.

I would like to congratulate all of the children and staff for their tremendous hard work and achievements, and to thank our parents for all that you do in supporting your children with their homework, as together we strive to achieve the very best outcomes for your children.
