PRAYER AND SERVICE

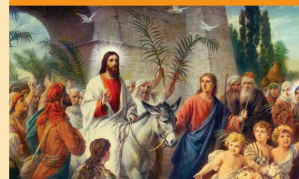
To be friends with Jesus
