Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to outline changes to the school's Wraparound Provision, and in particular to announce a significant extension to our after-school wraparound offer for your children.

The changes set out below will commence from the second week back after the Christmas holidays, the week beginning **Monday 13th January**:

Breakfast Club (available for Nursery, Reception, and Years 1-6)

- It will now be necessary to book and pay in advance for Breakfast Club through the Arbor App. We encourage parents to book well in advance due to limited places. No bookings will be accepted after 7.00 a.m. for Breakfast Club that day.
- The cost of Breakfast Club will increase to £3.00 per day (50% discount for Pupil Premium pupils). This price includes breakfast itself, up to 50 minutes of childcare, and guaranteed entry to Wake and Shake Up for 10 minutes of exercise to music before lessons commence.

After-school Club (available to Reception and Years 1-6)

 After-school Club will run Monday to Friday from 3.00 p.m. - 5.45 p.m. and consist of three sessions with the following costs:

3:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. £4.00 (for the first hour) (for Pupil Premium pupils there is a 50% discount for this first period only = £2.00)

4:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. £5.00 (for the second hour which includes a light tea)
5:00 p.m. - 5:45 p.m. £3.00 (for the third period)

- It will be necessary to book and pay in advance for all After-school Club provision through the Arbor App. Again, we encourage parents to book well in advance due to limited places. No bookings will be accepted after 12.00 noon for After-school Club that day.
- The first hour of provision, 3.00 4.00 p.m. will provide varying extra-curricular experiences, similar to existing after-school clubs; further information on this will be released soon.

Parents may recall being issued a survey on the need for extended provision prior to the summer break. We received a very positive response to that survey and since then we have been working with North Lincolnshire Council to secure some initial funding to help us establish this provision. Wraparound is not funded through the main school budget and the school is required to cover its costs – therefore, we very much will need the support of our families going forward to make the provision financially viable.

This letter has been issued to make parents aware of the forthcoming changes and to provide some of the key information for parents to consider over the holiday period.

Our Wraparound Policy containing further information, along with terms and conditions will be released in the first week back after the holidays. The booking system will also go live that week and once available we will announce this to parents.

We look forward to commencing our extended provision soon and very much hope that parents will support us by making use of the service.
