## After-School Extra-Curricular Clubs

We will be running a selection of after-school Extra-Curricular Clubs this Lent Term and all details are in the table below. Children can stay with us to play with Lego/blocks, learn how to make music or cook, as well as look after their well-being through mindfulness activities or simply enjoy a movie.

The clubs will begin straight after school every day, Monday to Friday and will finish at 4.00pm, apart from the Cooking Club which will finish at 4.15pm. Children can be collected from the academy hall. The price per session for all clubs is now £4.00. As previously, a discounted rate of £2.00 will be offered for children on means-tested free school meals.

The clubs will run for the whole duration of the Lent Term with the first club starting on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025 and the last clubs finishing on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025. Therefore, the cost to attend one of our clubs for the next 10 weeks will be £40 (£36 for the Music Club due to the academy being closed for training on 14<sup>th</sup> February). For children receiving means-tested free school meals the cost will be £20 (or £18 for the Music Club respectively).

Please note, all clubs will open for signing up on Arbor at the same time as the bookings for our After-School Care and Breakfast Club on Friday, 17th January 2025 at 7.00pm and an email/app message will be sent to notify Parents/Carers. You will then be able to sign up for the club your child would like to attend. Once you have completed the payment your child will be allocated a place in that club.

## Important notice:

At the point of signing up you will only be charged half price of £20.00 (£18.00 for Music Club). The remaining payment of £20.00 (or £18.00 respectively) will be due to be paid by 28th February 2025. Failure to pay the remainder will result in your child not being able to attend any more sessions after that date. Pupils receiving means-tested free school meals will not be prompted to pay the remaining amount due to their 50% discounted rate and can continue to attend the clubs as normal.

Wednesday	Key Stage 2 Movie Club with Miss Huxford 25 places	Years 3 – 6 Class 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12	Watch and discuss your favourite films with your friends! A movie may be started one week and carried onto the next week until it is finished. Popcorn will be provided.
Thursday	Construction Club with Mrs McIlvaney 25 places	Reception – Year 6 Class 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12	Various construction activities using different types of blocks, Creation Station, Design a Lego Person and other building challenges as well as colouring sheets.
