Dear Parents/Carers,

Pentecost Term 3.00-4.00pm After-School Clubs

We have prepared a new selection of after-school activities for all children in Classes 2 – 12 for the upcoming term in both Extra-Curricular Clubs and After-School Care. All details are in the table below. Please have a look and decide with your child/children which clubs they would like to join.

The clubs will begin straight after school every day of the term when the school is open, Monday to Friday, starting from Wednesday 23rd April, and will finish at 4.00pm with the last sessions taking place on Friday, 18th July. The price per session for all clubs is £4.00 with a discounted rate of £2.00 for children on the means-tested free school meals register. All Extra-Curricular Clubs are booked and charged for the whole term in advance while our After-School Care sessions can be booked as and when required up to the duration of the whole term if you book every week. Children can be collected from the academy hall at 4.00pm.

Please note that apart from our 3.00-4.00pm clubs, the After-School Care daily sessions are available on every day of the term until 5.45pm and you can add a 4.00-5.00pm or 4.00-5.45pm session on any day by booking them separately.

All clubs will open for signing up on Arbor on Monday, 7th April 2025 at 7.00pm. You will then be able to sign up for the club/s your child would like to attend. Once you have completed the payment your child will be allocated a place in the club/s.

Important notice:

At the point of signing up you will only be charged half price for the Extra-Curricular Clubs and the remaining payment will be due by 16th May 2025. Failure to pay the remainder will result in your child not being able to attend any more sessions after that date. Pupils receiving means-tested free school meals will not be prompted to pay the remaining amount due to their 50% discounted rate and can continue to attend the clubs as normal. Prices for our Extra-Curricular Clubs range from £40 to £48 per term (£20 to £24 at Pupil Premium rate) depending on the day of the week due to some days being lost to the mid-week start after the Easter break as well as the May Day Bank Holiday closure.
