For those children who have taken part in national tests across a number of year groups, parents will also receive their children's results together with their school report. The children and staff have been working very hard all year and we wish our pupils good success with their results.

Solar Panel Installation

Over recent weeks many parents may have seen the solar panel installation taking place at the school, which is part of the North Lincolnshire Community Energy Scheme (NLCE). I first registered our interest in being part of the NLCE a couple of years ago. There have been a number of processes to work through in order to bring the project to fruition, and we are delighted that work was able to commence during the half-term break and is now nearing completion.

Our solar panels span three different roofs on our site and can achieve a potential energy saving for the school in the range of 25–40% per annum of our total electricity costs, whilst also ensuring the school makes a positive contribution towards helping our environment.
