Catholic schools were founded by the Church to

- Assist in its mission of making Christ known to all people
- Assist parents, who are the primary educators of their children, in the education and religious formation of their children
- Be at the service of the local Church - the diocese, the parish and the Christian home
- Be 'a service to society'

Since September 2018, all maintained Catholic schools in the Diocese of Nottingham have become academies.

Each one belongs to one of three Catholic Multi-Academy Trusts (or CMATs).

The CMATs rely on local governors, attached to each of their academies, to support the designated school to thrive.

As practising Catholics, foundation governors help to ensure that the Catholic identity of the school is preserved, that the Bishop's vision for education is followed and that standards remain high.



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
